### Strong Fathers

- This prescribed program is a highly effective way to strengthen schools efforts in making fathers and families stronger partners in the education of their children. It incorporates events such as Bring Your Dad to School Day, Math Night, Science Night, and Reading Night that gets fathers in the classroom and allows them to see what their children do everyday in their school classrooms. The program aims at training classroom staff so that educators will gain a basic awareness and begin to develop a classroom plan for being more father and family friendly.

### Parents as Teachers

Parents also have access to monthly group meetings, developmental screenings, and information about other resources.
