House Bill 3

Per House Bill 3 (HB 3), passed by the 86th Texas Legislature in June of 2019, all kindergarten through third grade teachers and principals must attend a "teacher literacy achievement academy" by the 2021 - 2022 school year. House Bill 3 was updated by the 87th Texas Legislature in June 2021. It now states that all kindergarten through third grade teachers and principals must attend a "teacher literacy achievement academy" by the end of the 2022 - 2023 school year.

HB3 and **EPISD** Required Educators

K-3 Teachers, including Special Education Teachers Elementary and PK-8 Principals and Assistant Principals

Elementary and PK-8 Campus Teaching Coaches Elementary and PK-8 Reading Specialists Elementary and PK-8 Reading Interventionists

The 12-month professional development course grounded in the Science of Teaching Reading will positively impact student learning and professional development for teachers and administrators. The content presented in the 12-month course will build capacity at each EPISD elementary and K-8 campus with high-quality, effective literacy instructional strategies and practices to support student success.
