We understand that students apply to magnet programs as an optional program due to their specific focus. We recognize that acceptance to a magnet program is a privilege set forth by EPISD and not a right. We understand that standards may be higher than those required by other schools in the district may and that compliance with those standards is a requisite for continued enrollment in the magnet program. We understand that acceptable conduct, academic progress and regular attendance are mandatory for continued enrollment in the magnet program of choice.

We agree to abide by all EPISD policies and those set forth by the magnet program. Students who do not maintain academic standards will be subject to academic probation and exited from the magnet program. Our signatures indicate that we agree to support and adhere to program standards and parental roles now in existence and those that may be established in the future by individual magnet schools.

Please be aware that certain programs will require students to attend summer school, when offered, in order to fulfill the requirements for the magnet school. If a student leaves the magnet school and returns to his/her home school, the student is not eligible for varsity athletic competitions for at least one year from the date of enrollment in the home school.

I understand that eligible Silva students may participate in extra-curricular activities at Jefferson High School.
