Selection Process: First round applications will be accepted until November 20, 2020. Applications received after November 20th will be reviewed if space is available. Students must meet the following criteria:

- Must have an 85 or higher average in core subjects (Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies)
- Must have passed all STAAR tests (meets/masters) and/or district benchmarks
- 90% attendance rate

#### Part I. Student/Parent Commitment & Summer Programs

We understand that students apply to magnet programs as an optional program due to their specific focus. We recognize that acceptance to a magnet program is a privilege set forth by EPISD and not a right. We understand that standards may be higher than those required by other schools in the district may and that compliance with those standards is a requisite for continued enrollment in the magnet program. We understand that acceptable conduct, academic progress and regular attendance are required for continued enrollment in the magnet program.

We agree to abide by all EPISD policies and those set forth by the magnet program. Students who do not maintain academic standards will be subject to academic probation and exited from the magnet program. Our signatures indicate that we agree to support and adhere to program standards.

Please be aware that certain programs will require students to attend summer school, when offered, in order to fulfill the requirements for the magnet school. It is the parent and student's responsibility to inquire about such programs with magnet school staff. Understand that failure to comply with such requirement may to lead to revocation of admission if the magnet program deems it as necessary.

<u>Only an official acceptance letter confirms final acceptance to Silva Health Magnet High School.</u> Students **may not** join any Jefferson/Silva summer academic, athletic or fine arts programs without presenting an official acceptance letter to the coach or sponsor.

#### Part II. Rules of the University Interscholastic League as It Pertains to Athletics

As outlined in Section 440(B)(2)(B) of the University of Interscholastic League Constitution and Contest Rules: Students are eligible for varsity athletics the first year they have the opportunity to transfer to a magnet school. If a student leaves the magnet school and returns to his/her home school, the student is not eligible for varsity athletic competitions for at least one year from the date of enrollment in the home school.

I certify that I am applying to attend Silva Magnet High School because of the unique educational opportunities offered and not in order to participate in any specific extra-curricular activities. I understand that eligible Silva students may participate in extra-curricular activities at Jefferson High School. The University Interscholastic League governs these activities, and I agree to follow all UIL, State, and Local regulations regarding participation. Students residing outside EPISD may participate on freshman and junior varsity teams but are not eligible for varsity teams the first year at Silva.
