## **Conference Registration:**

- \$50 per 1 parent/guardian and any number of children. Additional parent/guardian \$25 each.
- Families must have at least one child who is d/Deaf or Hard of Hearing to qualify for the reduced rate and for free childcare services.
- High school students may attend for free. They must register to attend.
- Any special accommodation requests, such as interpreters, etc. for any attendee must be submitted with your registration to allow time for needs to be considered and arrangements to be made if approved.

## **Onsite Childcare Programs**

- Childcare is available during the conference on July 23 25, 2024
- The childcare programs are free and are open to your children who are d/Deaf or Hard of Hearing and their hearing siblings, aged 6 months to 14 years of age.
- Pre-registration for childcare is required to reserve a space.
- Childcare availability is on a first-come, first-served basis, so please register early.
- Onsite childcare registration will NOT be available. Childcare availability for children with special medical and/or behavioral needs is dependent on child/staff ratios.

## **Hotel Accommodations**

- A discounted hotel rate of \$131 \$191 is available at The AT&T Hotel and Conference Center.
- To receive the reduced rate, you must mention you are attending the conference (SWCED). Make your hotel
