

Jefferson/Silva Health Magnet High School

Congratulations! You are being considered for membership in the J.M. Whitaker Jefferson/Silva High School Chapter of National Honor Society due your excellent G.P.A. of 85 or higher. However, membership is not based on grades alone. Potential members are evaluated by the five-member faculty council on the criteria of scholarship, leadership, service, and character as stipulated by National Honor Society.

Your G.P.A. makes you eligible to fill out an NHS survey packet. Nevertheless, completion of this packet does not guarantee selection. All complete packets will give the council the necessary information about the potential member's leadership ability, service, and character. Members chosen by the faculty council will be inducted into the J.M. Whitaker Jefferson/Silva High School Chapter of National Honor Society in a formal induction in May.

## Prerequisites and selection process:

- Eligible candidates must have a cumulative GPA of 85.0.
- Opened to qualified sophomores and juniors.
- Students must have attended Jefferson/Silva the equivalent of one complete semester.
- Students must already have completed 15 school and 25 community service hours (between 12/19-3/20).
- Download the Student Survey/Application, complete it, and submit the typed Student Survey/Application by the deadline for further consideration. NO LATE SURVEYS WILL BE ACCPTED/CONSIDERED.
- Evaluation of the candidates' performance in the areas of leadership, service and character (in the classroom) will be done by the faculty.
- The Faculty Council shall review the Student Survey/Application and the faculty evaluations on the individual students before a vote on membership is taken. The Faculty Council will consider the following:
  - Community and School Service hours: A minimum of 15 school hours and 25 community hours beginning December, 2019 through March, 2020.
  - Attendance: <u>Students, please obtain the ATP38 Attendance Report from the</u> <u>attendance office and attach this report to the back of the packet</u>. Please obtain this report in a timely manner in order to verify attendance accuracy. Unexcused absences/more than 5 absences in the fall semester and excessive tardiness may result in the candidate not being considered for membership.
  - **Discipline referrals**: The NHS advisor will obtain this information. If you have had a disciplinary referral during the current school year, it might preclude your consideration for acceptance.
  - Three faculty endorsements: From most current math, science and English teachers.
- The final selection of members shall be by the majority vote of the Faculty Council consisting of five teachers appointed by the principal. The chapter advisor shall be a non-voting, ex-officio member of the Faculty Council. The NHS Faculty Council meets and reviews the teachers' input and the students' survey packets. Candidates are subsequently approved or disapproved. All decisions are derived in an objective fashion. Students selected by the Faculty Council are those who demonstrate outstanding performance in all four criteria of scholarship, leadership, service and character.
- \* NHS Faculty Council decisions are final. There is no right to membership. It is a privilege bestowed upon a student by the faculty of the school.

Please complete all sections and print it. Bring your typed/completed packet, as well as the ATP Attendance Report and the signed instruction sheet to Mr. Keich in room 104 no later than Monday, March 23 by 2:30 p.m.

## NO LATE SURVEYS WILL BE ACCEPTED. NO EXCEPTIONS. SURVEYS ARE TO BE TURNED IN PERSONALLY TO MS. ADA AND NOT BY A THIRD PARTY.
