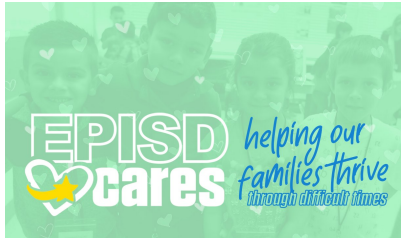

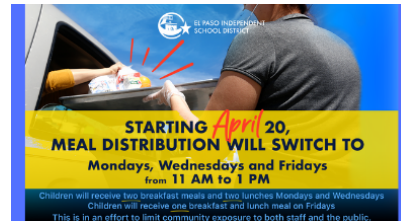


EPISD Cares
