EPISD Meal Distribution For Children




The El Paso Independent School District on Monday has begun the distribution of meals for children who may be impacted by school closures throughout the El Paso region. The free breakfasts and lunches will be available to any child ages 1-18 regardless of their enrollment status with the District.

EPISD will provide take-home meals for students at 50 school sites throughout the District in a drive-thru setting. No dining will be allowed in the cafeteria in order to practice social distancing recommended by health officials.

Take-home lunches and breakfasts for the next day will be distributed from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. during the emergency preparedness weeks of March 23-27 and March 30-April


Sun Metro Providing Free Bus Service
