Franklin P-TECH blends high school and college coursework and provides students the opportunity to earn up to 60 college hours towards an Associate Degree of Arts in Multidisciplinary Studies, as well as an industry certification in Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), at no cost to the student of his/her family.

Frankin P-TECH offers students a pathway that will lead to post-secondary credentials and is an experience that encourages students to continue their higher education journey.

- Opportunity to graduate with up to 60 college credit hours and an Associates Degree of Arts in Multidisciplinary Studies that may be transferable to any state-supported college and university in Texas.
- Dual-credit courses mirroring a college setting offered in partnership with El Paso Community College
- Academic counseling to help students develop skills needed for post-high school success.

Program Requirements/Expectations

- There is, no criteria for placement into the Pathways in Technology Early College High School, but the student must be willing to work toward earning an associate degree and/or industry certification.
- College and Career advising is provided to plan future career and educational options and opportunities.
