

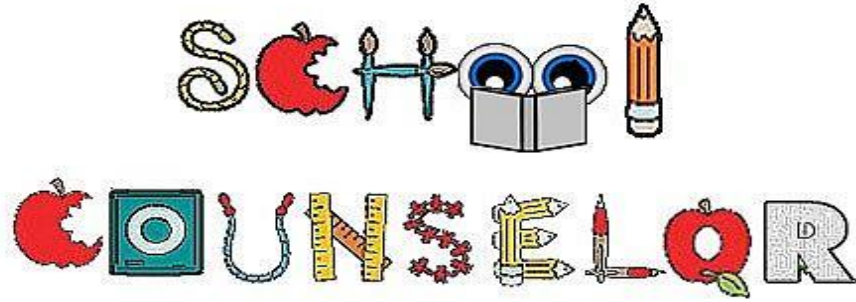

Pre-AP/AP vs. Regular Classes

- Colleges always look for rigor of schedule.
- Per FHS policy, students are not allowed to drop Pre-Ap/AP classes after first day of class.

Top 10% Rule

Students who graduate in the top ten percent of their graduating class are eligible for admission to any *public* college or university in Texas.

****Exception UT Austin admits top 6%***

AP vs. Dual Credit

AP

- AP classes ALWAYS count as HS credit.
- Classes are taken on the FHS Campus.
- College level coursework with an AP exam that could *potentially* earn college credit.
- Acceptance of credit nationwide is based on the individual University. Typically a score of 3 or higher is required to earn credit. **Student must contact college to verify acceptance.**
- Open enrollment
- Students must pay to take the AP exam. (Fee is much less if you qualify for Free and Reduced Lunch.)

AP

- ▶ Las clases AP SIEMPRE cuentan como crédito de preparatoria
- ▶ Las clases son en el campus de Franklin.
- ▶ Las clases de nivel universitario PODRIAN darte créditos para la universidad
- ▶ **La aceptación de créditos a nivel nacional es basada en cada universidad individualmente. Típicamente, una calificación de 3 o más se requiere para obtener crédito. Cada estudiante debe contactar la universidad para verificar aceptación del crédito.**
- ▶ **Inscripción Abierta**
- ▶ **El estudiante debe pagar para tomar el examen AP (la cuota es mucho más baja si calificas para almuerzo o comida gratis o de precio reducido)**



AP vs. Dual Credit

Dual Credit

- Check with your chosen college to see if the DC course counts as the named HS course or as an elective.
- Classes are taken on the FHS Campus.
- Coursework will transfer to most Texas public universities with a grade of “C” or better. Coursework **might** transfer to other Universities. **Student must contact college to verify acceptance.**
- **Students must meet TSI (college readiness) standards to enroll.**
- Tuition is free.

Credito Dual

- Confirma con la universidad de tu elección para ver si el curso de doble crédito cuenta como una electiva.
- Las clases se toman en el campus de Franklin.
- El curso se transfiere a la mayoría de las universidades públicas de Texas con una calificación de C o más. La clase podría transferirse a otras universidades. El estudiante es responsable de contactar a la universidad para verificar aceptación.
- **Los estudiantes deben cumplir con los estándares de TSI para inscribirse**
- La colegiatura es gratis.

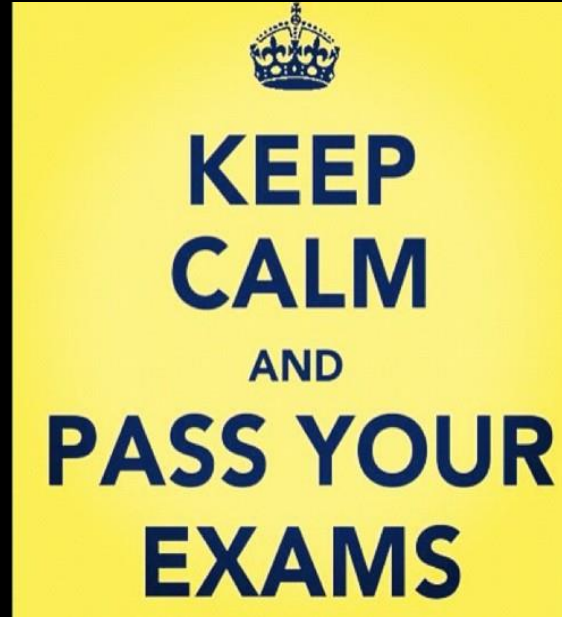

What is an Endorsement?

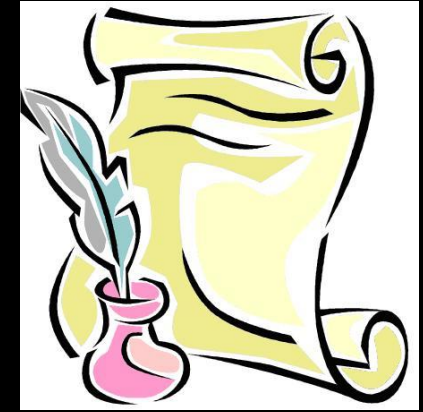
An endorsement is earned when a student completes a sequence of courses in a concentrated area of study.

- *Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics (STEM)



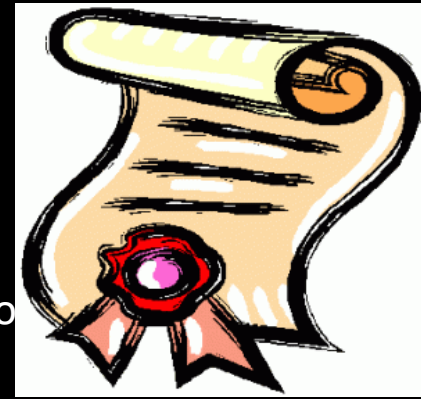

Dual Credit Courses: Complete 12 DC hours with a 3.0 or higher, or earn an Associate degree while in high school

ADVANCED PLACEMENT or IB: Earn a score of 3 or above on an AP exam, or earn a score of 4 or above on an IB exam.

PSAT,ACT-ASPIRE,SAT, or ACT:

PSAT, ACT-PLAN, ACT/SAT Scores: Earn a total score of 1310 on SAT, Earn a composite score of 28 on ACT, Earn National Merit Recognition on PSAT, or earn college readiness benchmarks on at least three of the five subject tests on ACT Aspire

BUSINESS OR INDUSTRY CERTIFICATION/LICENSE: Earn an nationally recognized business or industry certification or earn a certification or licensure representing a student's substantial course of study or end of program knowledge

Clases de Doble Crédito: Completa 12 horas con un 3.0 o más, u obtén un título técnico mientras estas en la preparatoria.

Colocación Avanzada IB: Obtén una calificación de 3 o más en un examen AP, u obtén un 4 o más en un examen IB
