Parent/Guardian Introduction

The El Paso Independent School District continues preparing the reopening plan for the 2020-2021 school year. Your feedback as a parent or guardian is critical to this process, since plans must be responsive to the needs of our students and families while simultaneously prioritizing the health, safety, and well-being of our community. It is important to recognize that schools must operate differently when campuses do reopen. Exactly how we reimagine schools opening in the fall is the work we must do together in consultation with our School Board, health professionals, and government. **Please keep in mind that for the 2020-2021 school year, all students, staff and visitors will be required to wear face masks and adhere to social distancing guidelines.**

We understand that your feedback might be different depending on the age and needs of your children. With this in mind, we ask that you utilize this brief survey for each of your children enrolled at EPISD. Please note that ALL groups will begin on Aug. 17 with virtual learning through EPISD@Home. Campuses will open for Groups A/B and D on Sept. 8 for face-to-face instruction once authorized by the governor and Texas Education Agency (TEA).

- Select Special Program group is based on certain groups of learners who experience adverse effects in a virtual learning environment and includes our English Learner newcomers, Title, Kinder, 1st, 2nd, and specific students with disabilities that are better served face-to-face students.
- Of note, all of these families can choose virtual (EPISD@Home), but the district is prioritizing face-to-face instruction to serve these students.
- Group C represents students who are 100% virtual instruction through EPISD@Home.

The table identifies 4 groups of learners:

- Group A- 50% of a campus's enrollment on campus for 2 days a week (Monday and Tuesday) and virtual 3 days (Wednesday - Friday)
- Group B- 50% of a campus's enrollment on campus for 2 days a week (Thursday and Friday) and virtual 3 days (Monday - Wednesday)
- Group C- 100% virtual 5 days a week for the entire first semester
- Group D- Select Special Programs Group- 5 days per week, either half or whole day on campus (depending on family responses). This group of students includes certain eligible English Learners, PreK, Kinder, 1st, and 2nd, and specific students with disabilities better served face to face. Families of students in the Select Special Programs Group can choose EPISD@Home, but EPISD is prioritizing face to face instruction for students in this group.

Depending on the number of families who choose virtual instruction through EPISD@Home, we may be able to serve more students face to face. We are making some adjustments to our virtual learning environment to provide more face time with teachers, reduce the amount of responsibility on our staff, and ensure students are receiving quality instruction. Ultimately both the safety of students and staff as well as the learning experience are our top priorities.





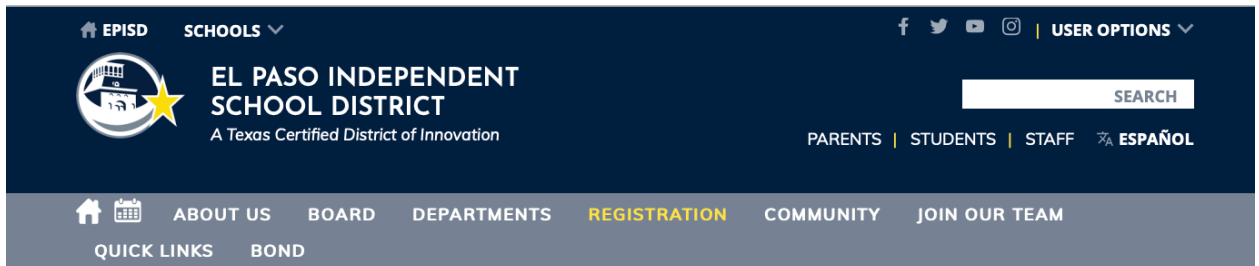

STEP 1 Click on the button to register online

STEP 4 Submit documents.

All required documents: **Immunization Record** and **Proof of Residence** (gas, water or electric bill) may be submitted online. **Returning students** must have proof of residence either uploaded, emailed, or faxed to the campus.

STEP 5 Click here to make an appointment.

Online registration must be completed and all documents uploaded prior to making an appointment. Campus visits will be kept to a minimum and appointments must be made. **New students must complete the enrollment process with the registrar prior to making an appointment with the counselor. Returning students do not need to book an appointment with the registrar.** Appointments with the counselor only need to be made if you have a particular situation to discuss with the counselor. Elementary Clerks and all counselors will not be on duty until July.
