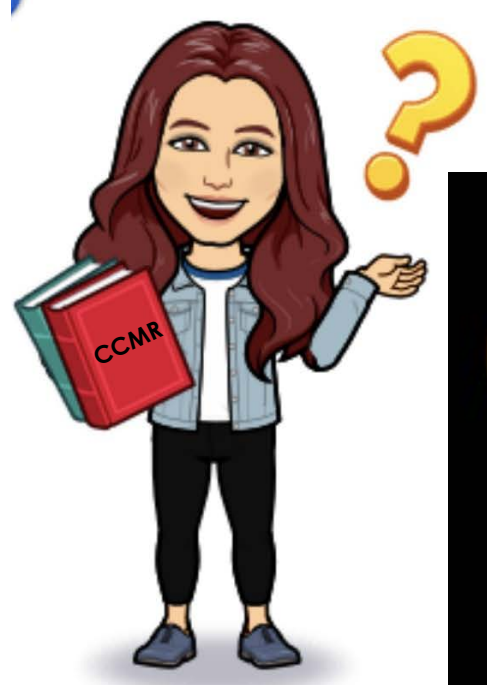

# ADVICE FOR PARENTS

Yes, there are things you can do to help your senior prepare for continuing their education after high school.

- It is important to attend financial aid presentations and career day functions WITH your scholar. Many of these events are virtual and will be held in the evenings and on weekends.
- Ask them monthly, "Have you been to the Mapping Your Future websites? What are you working on and what scholarships have you applied for?"
- Sit down with your student and prepare a list of what he/she is looking for in a college and then help him/her sort through the information they receive from the different institutions to decide which ones offer what's on the list.



# ADVICE FOR PARENTS

- Complete applications with your scholar.
- In October, [register for an FSA ID](#) so you can assist your student with financial aid forms.
- In October or November, you will need to help your student complete the FAFSA.
  - Your FSA ID will help speed up the process.
- In late winter or early spring, the award notices will start coming in. Look at the financing carefully and contact the schools with any questions. Make comparisons!
- Go on virtual trips with your scholars to as many of his or her top school choices as possible.  
A virtual visit to the campus is invaluable to making a decision.
- Don't hesitate to reach out of guidance. We are here to help.

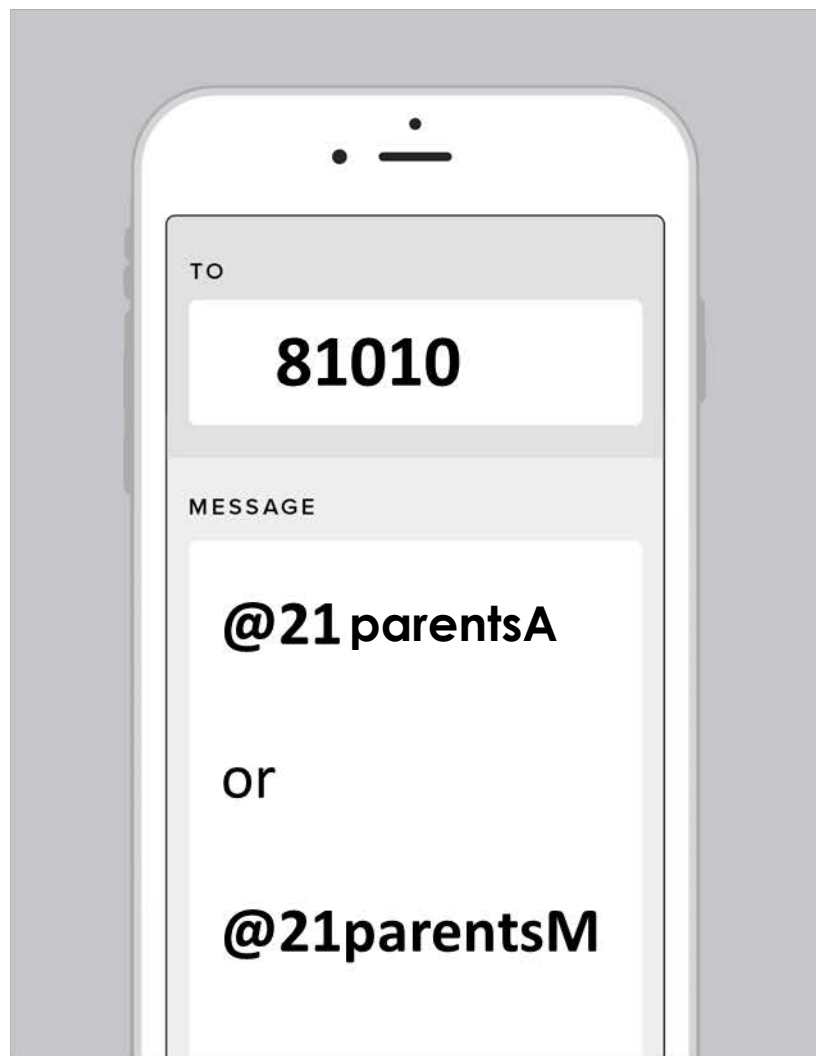


# Schoology Virtual Classroom

(Accounts are only allotted 150 participants per class! This is NOT a group text account.)
