Remember, you must be enrolled in a minimum of 3 Pre-AP, AP, Dual Credit, or OnRamps courses, AND STAY ENROLLED IN THEM, to request an out. Students, do not put this off until the last minute....especially if parent, teacher, or a coach's signature is required! **December 13 is the FINAL DEADLINE.**
