



STEM Endorsement: Computer Science Program of Study ENDORSEMENT = 4+ Classes in a Row (like a major)



TSI Test

- All PTECH students, who have NOT taken EDU 1300, are required to take the English TSI test during intersession.
- Students need a score of 945 on multiple choice section and a 5 on the essay component.
- Testing dates: October 3, October 4 and October 5
- Check your **school email** for testing appointment (date/time)

What is the TSI Test?


- The TSI Assessment (TSIA) is part of the Texas Success Initiative program designed to help your college or university determine if you are ready for college-level course work in the general areas of reading, writing, and mathematics.
- Areas tested include
 - Math (Algebra 2 skills necessary)
 - English Language Arts (multiple choice), and an Essay.
