### **Arrival and Dismissal Times and Locations**

### **Arrival Procedures**

- All students report directly to the cafeteria upon arrival. Students must be dropped off at the car loop. Parents walking students to school will leave them at student entrance.
- Morning recess is from 7:50 to 8:10 a.m. The teachers pick up students at 8:10. Parents will not be allowed in the building at arrival. <u>This is for the health</u>, safety, and security of all students.
- \*\*Earliest Drop off is at 7:30 am if eating breakfast and 7:45 for all other students.

Anyone arriving after 8:25 am will need to go through front entrance and will receive a tardy slip.

### Dismissal Procedures: 3:35 pm

- Students in 2nd-5th will leave their classroom at 3:35 pm. PreK-1st at 3:30 pm.
- Students 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> will be picked at the main car loop.
- Students Pre-K-1<sup>st</sup> will be picked up in the back car loop by the gym, with parent walk ups by gate
- For student safety the main parking lot will be closed to parents at dismissal. Parents may park in the back parking lot or at Hornedo
- Older siblings will walk to the pick up area of their younger sibling.

### **General Information**

- Instruction starts promptly at 8:25
- Laptops and iPads will be used in class to supplement instruction not as a primary teaching tool and will remain at school
- Each student will receive a planner for the school year
- O Drop off meds with Nurse Meza
- Tutoring will be offered throughoutthe school year
