



Charles Middle School DRESS CODE POLICY



TOPS



- Plain solid colored **polo** (short or long sleeve) in school colors: **green, black or gray in color** - with or without school logo.
- Zippered jackets - (school colors ONLY- NO large graphics) or Charles Hoodies.
 - *No oversized hoodies or jackets. A proper uniform shirt must be worn under all jackets & hoodies.*
- Charles sports or club shirts, hoodies & jackets (*with school logo and/or name*) are allowed. **Andress** shirts allowed on Spirit Fridays- NO other high schools.
- Layered undershirts must be in school colors.

BOTTOMS



- **Black or khaki/ tan pants, jeans, shorts, skirts, skorts or blue jeans. NO joggers**
 - *Blue Jeans must NOT have ANY rips, tears, or distressing of any kind. **Blue jeans worn ONLY on Mondays and Fridays with college shirt (Mondays) or Charles/Andress school spirit shirt (Fridays).***
- Pants must be fitted & worn properly at the waist. NO baggy or oversized bottoms & NO pants below the waist. A belt is strongly encouraged (*black or brown belts only*).
- Shorts/Skorts/Skirts must be fitted & length should be longer than your fingertips when arm is fully extended down the side of the body.

SHOES

Shoes must be athletic or uniform style shoes- closed toe.
NO sandals, crocs, slippers, slides, boots, or flip-flops allowed.



PE

- Students may wear official school PE t-shirt or just a plain, solid colored t-shirt (**green, gray, black, or white in color**)
- Shorts, leggings, joggers allowed for PE only

Students change into PE clothes during PE but MUST change back into uniform after class.



UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS



- No hats, beanies, or sunglasses are to be worn in the building.
- Hoodies must be off while in building.
- No Body piercings (except ears)
- No gauges.
- No tanks, spaghetti straps, crop-tops, midriff or ripped tops.
- All clothing must be free from profanity, illegal drugs/paraphernalia, or explicit images or content.
- No pajama wear.
- **No electronic devices of any kind** are to be worn or used the building unless allowed by a teacher for classroom purposes.
