UPDATES ON COVID PROTOCOLS PRINCIPAL PAZ

CONFIRMED COVID PROTOCOLS

Updated by EPISD 8/9/2021

When a Confirmed Positive is Reported to our Nurse

1. A parent/guardian reports a COVID positive result or submits documentation to our Nurse

2. Nurse will ask the following:

- Is the student showing symptoms? If No, and student is vaccinated, they may return to campus. If yes and vaccinated, they may return 24 hours after symptoms showing
- If child is not vaccinated, they will quarantine for a minimum of 10 days and nurse will ask the following:
- When was the last day student was on campus?
- Did student ride the bus?
- Who did they eat lunch with?
- Do they participate in sports or after school activities?

When a Confirmed Positive is Reported to our Nurse 3. Nurse will notify Mr. Paz and contact tracing will be conducted by Administration

Must identify when student was last on campus and what classes he/she attended

Will identify where student was sitting in each class (teachers have up to date seating charts)

 Any student sitting six feet or closer to positive student for 15 or more minutes will be sent to nurse for further questioning

Any student sent to nurse will be asked the following (by the nurse):

- Have you been vaccinated?
- When was the date of your second dose?

lf student is vaccinated:

If student is two weeks post second vaccination shot and is not symptomatic, student may return to class.

If student is not two weeks from second shot, they must enter 10-day quarantine

Quarantine will begin from the last day student was exposed

If Student is NOT Vaccinated



Student will be required to quarantine for a minimum of 10 days from the last day of exposure Student will be placed in designated quarantine room until parent/guardian or TEAMs identified individual can pick them up Student will be coded "COVID Related Absence" and begin remote instruction until they return to campus

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Remote Instruction:

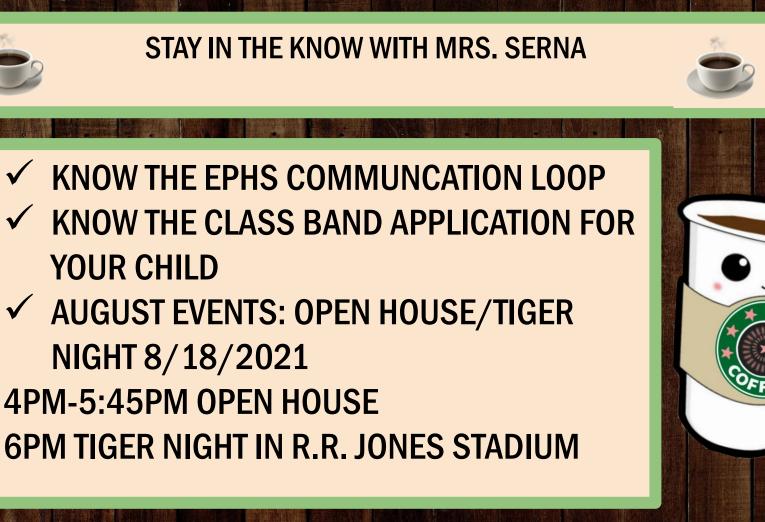
Rei When student is coded "COVID related absence" the absences will not count against the student

Attendance will notify teachers of students entering quarantine

Teachers will use Schoology/teacher website to support remote learning

Teachers may support remote instruction by utilizing some or all of the following:

- Zoom Links
- Daily assignments/readings
- Pre-Recorded videos of instruction
- Links to support instrction (Kahn, Nearpod, NoRedInk, IXL, etc.)
