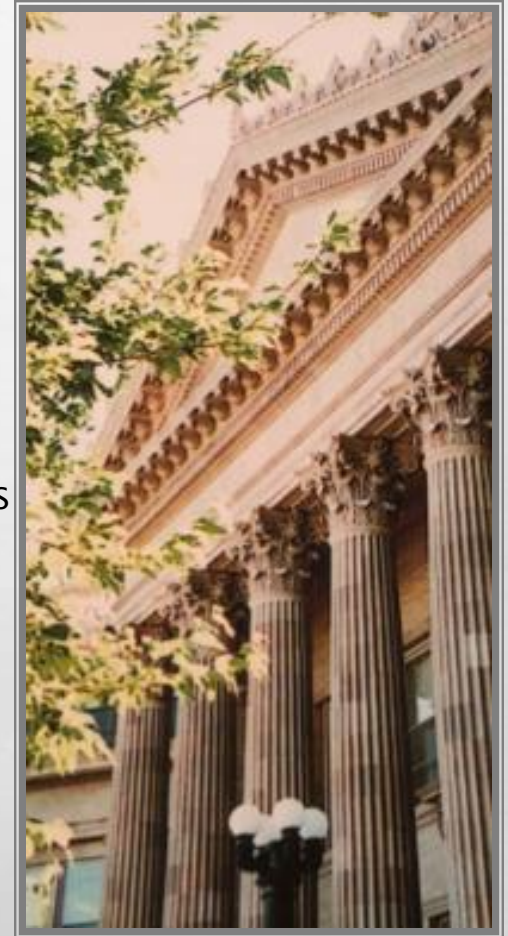

# THE BASICS

## HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT AND GRADING



- ALL COURSES WORTH .5 CREDIT PER SEMESTER
- A COURSE USUALLY 2 PARTS, 1 PER SEMESTER  
(EX: ALGEBRA 1A AND 1B)
- EARN CREDIT BY PASSING EACH SEMESTER (70%)
- GRADING:
  - 2, 9-WEEK GRADING PERIODS PER SEMESTER
    - 20% = CONTENT ENGAGEMENT
    - 20% = CONTENT UNDERSTANDING
    - 40% = CONTENT MASTERY
  - FINAL COURSE GRADE:
    - 85% FALL SEMESTER
    - 85% SPRING SEMESTER
    - 10% FINAL EXAM
- 26 CREDITS = HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA
- 32 CREDITS = EPHS BLOCK SCHEDULING

# LET'S TALK ADVANCED COURSES

- 1) OPEN TO ALL STUDENTS-BUT MUST HAVE RECEIVED CREDIT IN PREVIOUS COURSE(\*EXCEPT DUAL CREDIT)
- 2) MORE RIGOROUS THAN ON-LEVEL COURSES
- 3) **REQUIRE HOURS OF STUDY TIME, PLANNING AND ORGANIZATION**
- 4) **DUAL CREDIT DROPS CAN AFFECT FINANCIAL AID**
- 5) **DC GRADES ARE PERMANENT ON COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT**
- 6) **ON RAMPS AND AP COURSES ARE ADDED TO HS TRANSCRIPT**

SELECT COURSES THAT ARE IN ALIGNMENT WITH YOUR FUTURE GOALS.

FOR EXAMPLE, IF YOU PLAN ON BEING AN ENGINEER YOU WOULD TAKE ADDITIONAL MATH COURSES BUT MAYBE NOT ADDITIONAL SOCIAL STUDIES COURSES.
