- Relief for Cafeteria Personnel





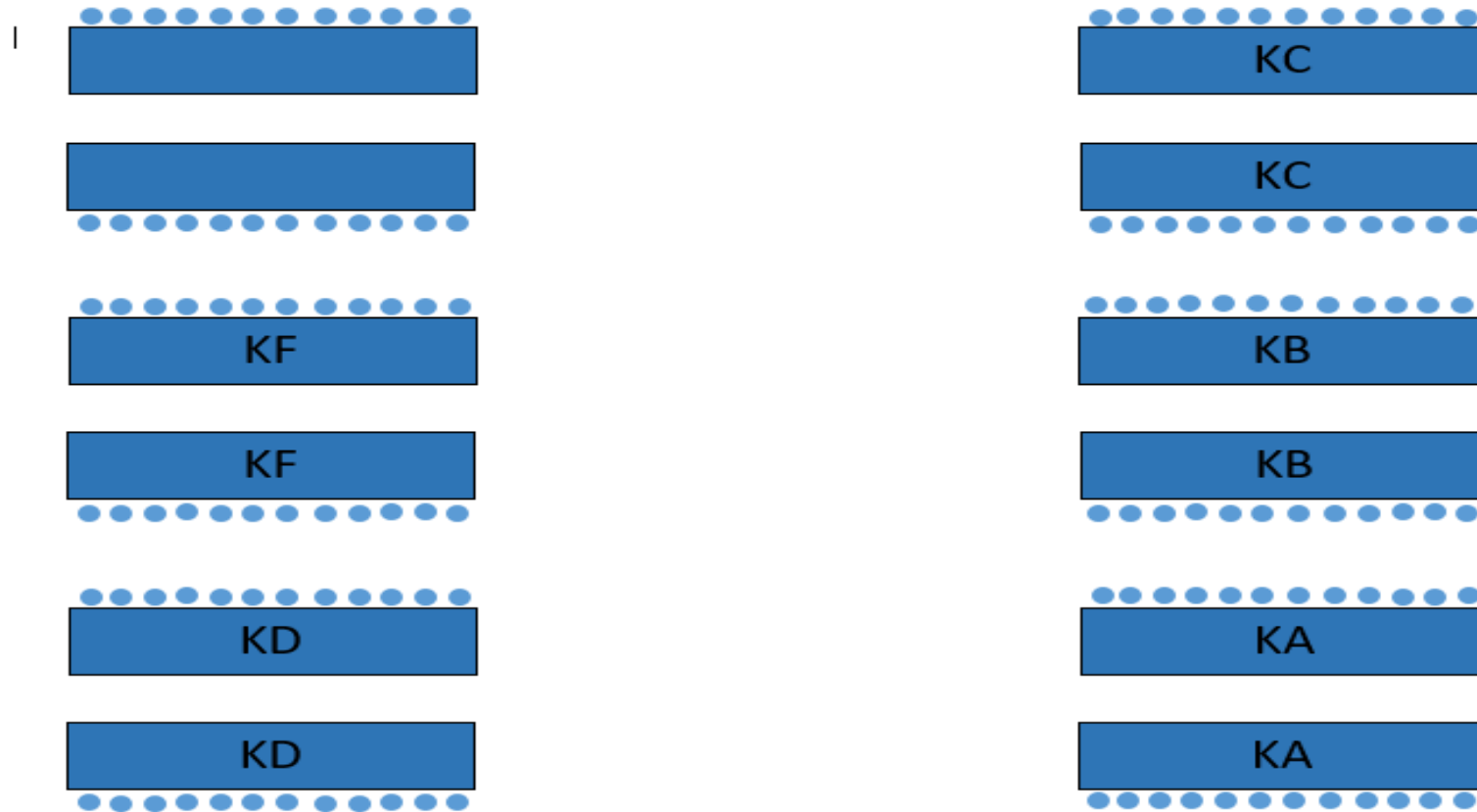

# Cafeteria Set-Up for Kinder

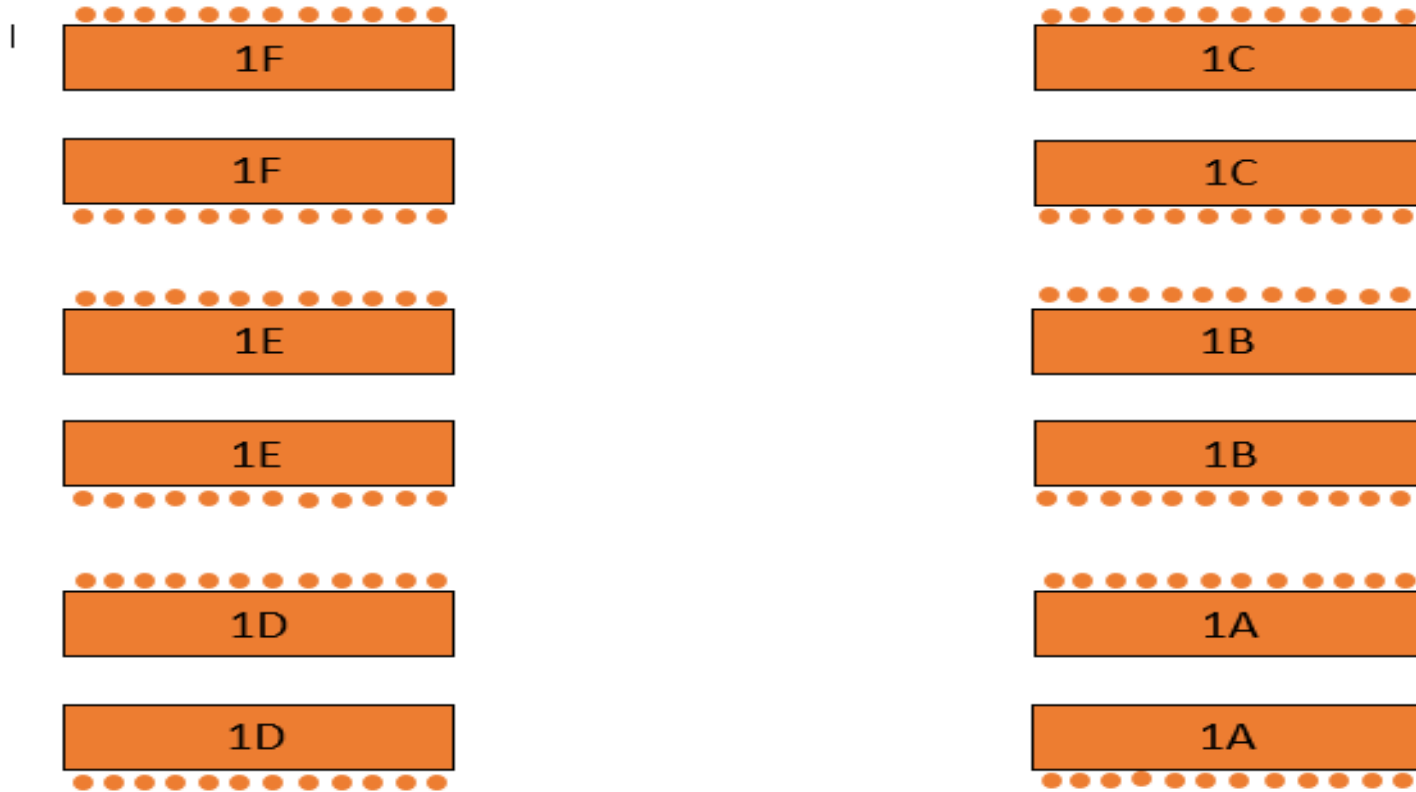


12 tables with 24 seats each = 288

288 seats will allow us to sit students on one side only, and skip seats to ensure Social Distance (appropriate distance)



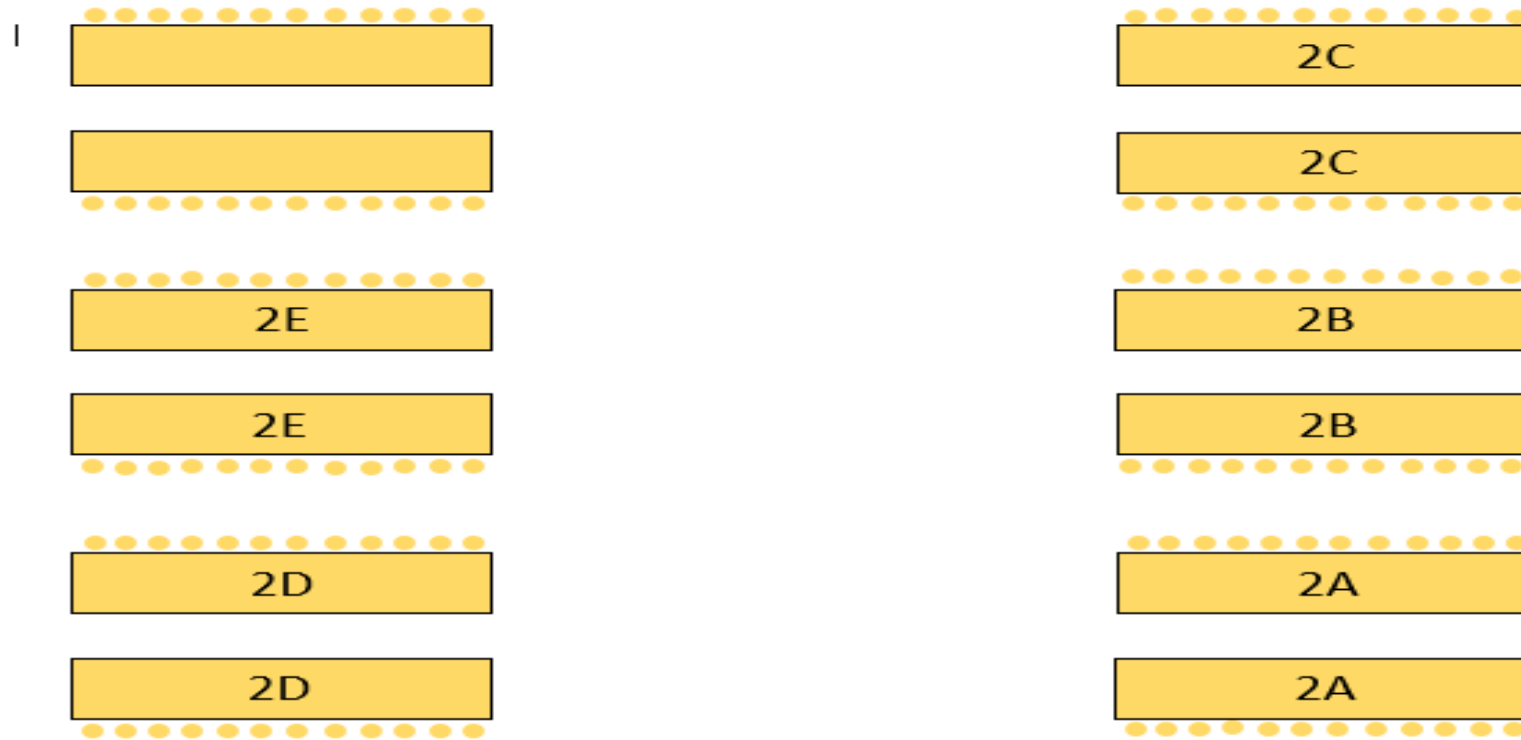
# Cafeteria Set-Up for First Grade

288 seats will allow us to sit students on one side only, and skip seats to ensure Social Distance (appropriate distance)

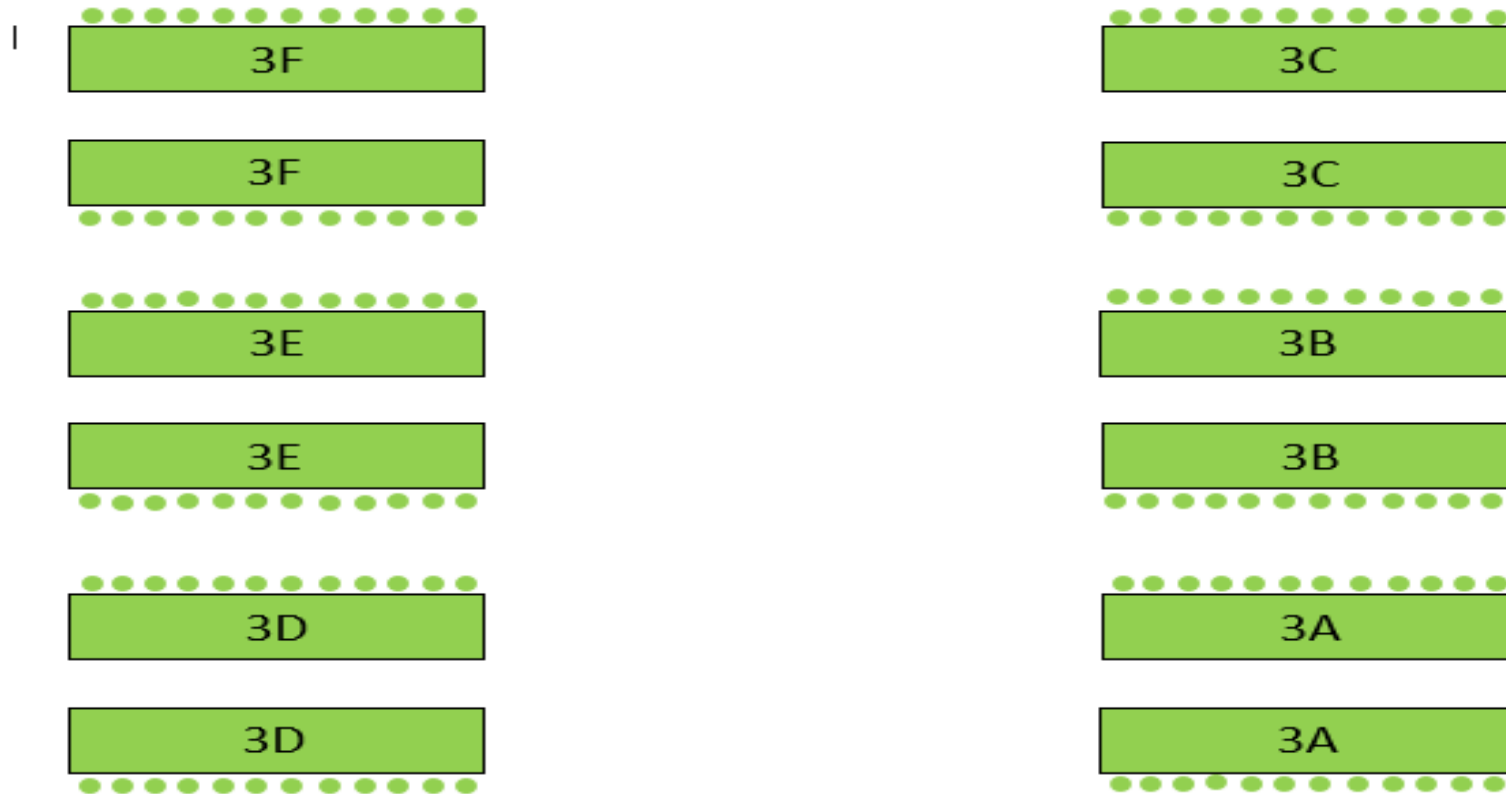
# Cafeteria Set-Up for Second Grade

288 seats will allow us to sit students on one side only, and skip seats to ensure Social Distance (appropriate distance)

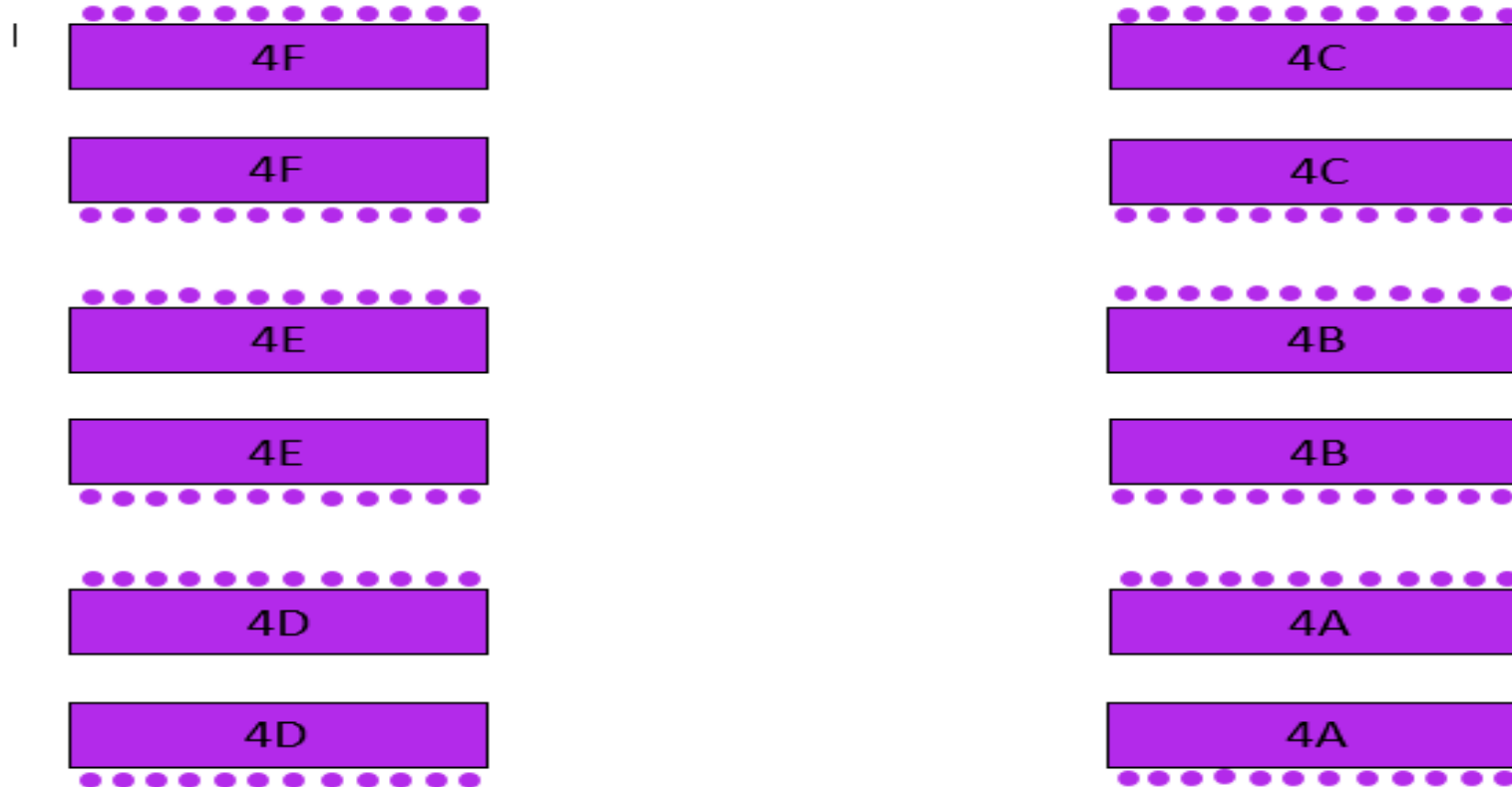
# Cafeteria Set-Up for Third Grade

288 seats will allow us to sit students on one side only, and skip seats to ensure Social Distance (appropriate distance)

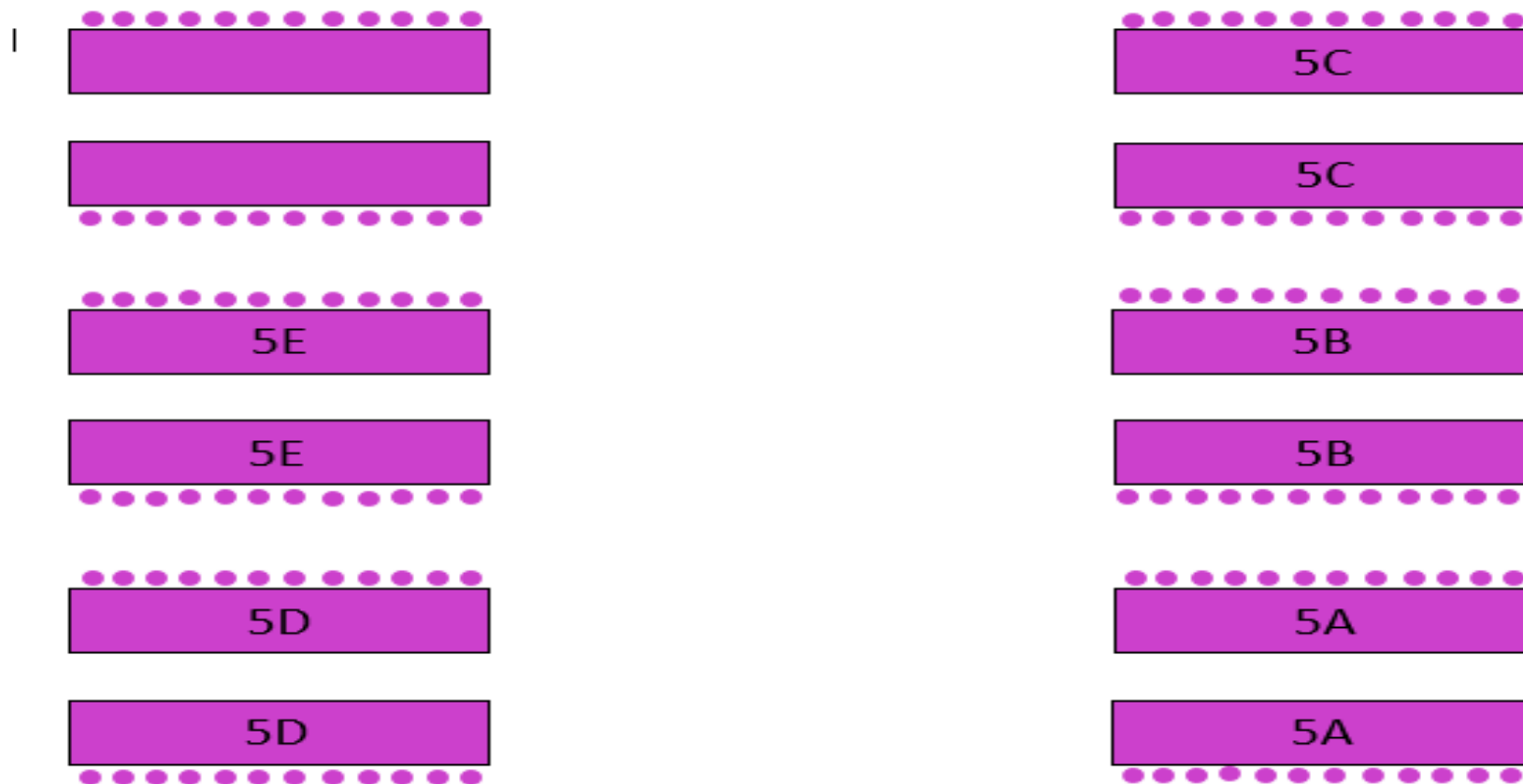
# Cafeteria Set-Up for Fourth Grade

# Safety Protocols

## Cafeteria and Recess

- In the cafeteria, students will be asked to have mask on, except when they are eating.
- For recess, students will be asked to wear mask unless they are running.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers are available in classrooms, cafeteria, gym and black top.
- Appropriate distance (as per CDC Guidelines) will be enforced.
- If students do not comply, privilege will be taken away.
- Tables will be cleaned and sanitized between each lunch shift.

# Polk Logistics

## Week 1

- Teachers will walk their students to cafeteria.
- Students will continue to get their food “packaged” as they have been getting it in classroom. If they bring lunch, they will continue to bring lunch.
- Administrators and Counselor will each supervise the daily 3 shifts in the cafeteria.
- Students will be allowed to participate in recess, Coaches will help out with getting them from Cafeteria and bringing them back, teachers will meet them and bring them to classroom. (there will be enough time for this transition).
- This process will be repeated for Week 2.

# Polk Logistics

- Seating Chart Needed for each class, each grade level
- All stakeholders will be informed
- Parent Communication through letters, parent meeting and class apps
- Starting day: April 19
- Polk is a pilot school representing the West Side
- Breakfast will continue to be served in the classrooms



# What will recess look like?

- Field and black top will be available.
- “Playground structure” will be closed
- “Peaceful” recess activities will be available
- Individual sports activities will be emphasized
- Students will not share equipment
