

2. PANTS: Revised 7/16/21

- Students may wear uniform pants either khaki or black or blue jeans
- Full length jeans free of holes, tattered material or other distressed material may not be worn.
- Uniform Capri's and shorts must be khaki or black.
- > Clothing must fit appropriately (NO skin-tight or over-sized clothing).
- Shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches from the knee-cap, and no longer than 1 inch past the knee cap.
- > Your pants/bottoms must be worn at waist level.
- > Sagging or hanging attire is not permitted.
- > Sweat-like material, tights, and spandex are prohibited.
- > Jean shorts are not allowed
- Administration reserves the right to determine whether or not an article of clothing is appropriate and may request students change any article of clothing found to be distracting or inappropriate for school.

JACKETS/SWEATERS/SWEATSHIRTS:

- Students may wear sweatshirts and jackets that are appropriate for the school setting.
- School uniform polo shirts must be worn underneath sweaters, sweatshirts, and jackets.
- Administration reserves the right to determine whether or not an article of clothing is appropriate and may request students remove outerwear found to be distracting or inappropriate for school.
- Hoods may not be worn inside the buildings, including the cafeteria.



Belts and shoes

• BELTS (optional):

- If you decide to wear a belt with your uniform, your belt cannot have a military style buckle, any initials, studs or be gang related.
- Buckles in the shape of an offensive object or distracting material are not allowed.
- SHOES:
- Sneakers are recommended as children play throughout the day.
- Shoes that can be converted into roller skates, slippers, flip-flops, metal-toed shoes, taps, opentoed sandals, backless shoes, and slip-ons are not allowed.

Appearance

JEWELRY AND ACCESSORIES:

- Small, stud-type earrings are allowed and hoop earrings that are one inch in diameter or smaller may be worn.
- Body piercing, temporary tattoos, or facial or body stickers/paint, chains, collars, studded bracelets/necklaces, rosaries, and any type of jewelry that could present a safety hazard are not allowed.
- You are not allowed to wear sunglasses unless you have a doctor's prescription.

• MAKE-UP:

• You are allowed to wear a little make-up, but it should not alter your normal appearance.

• HAIR:

 Your hair color has to be your natural color (e.g. NO pink, purple, blue, green).

 Hairstyles, haircuts or hair colors, shavedhair designs that are considered to be a distraction, and partially-shaved eyebrows will be considered a violation of the school dress code.

Hats and P.E.

• HEAD COVERING:

- Hats, visors, caps, headbands, hairnets, bandanas or any other head coverings or any other item considered to be a distraction are not permitted while you are on campus.
- Hats or other head coverings will be taken away if seen on campus.

- P.E. UNIFORM POLICY
- 1. Solid Gray or Maroon t-shirt (Canyon Hills logo only or solid color).
- 2. Solid maroon or gray shorts
- 3. Solid maroon or gray warm ups.
