2019 – 2020 Dress Code Policy

It is important that students are in uniform daily. If students come to school out of uniform, it takes away from their instructional time. Students will have to call home for a change of clothes or borrow from the loan closet. Our goal is to keep our scholars in class and participating in their learning.

Uniform Items:

- Tops: black, turquoise, or grey polo shirts with the Brown Middle School logo or band logos no larger than 2 inches in diameter.
- Bottoms: black or khaki cotton twill pants, capris, shorts, skorts, or skirts (knee length or longer).
- Outerwear: light weight black, turquoise, or grey solid in color jackets, sweaters, or hoodies with no writing or images on the chest, back, or sleeves. Brown Middle School logos are allowed and encouraged. Uniform top must be worn beneath.
- Shoes must fully cover toes and heels.
- College Shirt Thursday, students are allowed to wear a college top on Thursday's. This does not include professional sports teams.
- Brown Spirit/club t-shirts are allowed Friday's with school uniform bottoms.

Non-uniform Days: Students will follow the EPISD dress code policy.

Unacceptable (uniform and non-uniform items):

- Oversized, baggy, sagging, low rise, skinny pants, leggings, or jeggings.
- Pants with holes, frayed edges, or tears.
- Extreme make-up
- Excessive jewelry
- Hoop earrings longer than 1" in diameter
- Gauges or ear spikes
- Chains
- Writing on clothing
- Studded items
- Facial piercings
- Sandals, slippers, open-toed or backless shoes, crocs, or flip-flops
- Pajama wear
- Tank tops/Spaghetti straps
- Low cut shirts
- See-through shirts
- Crop tops (shows midriff)

Physical Education Uniform:

- Tops: plain grey or with the Brown Middle School logo, loose fitting cotton t-shirt
- Bottoms: black shorts to the knee or cotton sweat pants
- Socks and athletic shoes
- NO oversized or tight fitting clothing, yoga pants, or cut-off sleeves or pant legs
