



JEFF/SILVA DRESS CODE 2021-2022

Purpose: Everyone will be dressed properly and exercise good judgment regarding their manner of dress and grooming. The dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, instill discipline, prevent disruption, avoid safety hazards, and teach respect for authority.

Tops

- All tops (shirts, blouses, t-shirts, etc.) worn at Jeff/Silva must have straps of two inches in width or sleeves.
- All tops must not have a plunging neckline, no low-cut.
- Midriffs cannot show more than the width of the student's two fingers with arms at side, while student is standing straight. In other words, there is a space of two fingers wide between the pant waistline and the bottom of the shirt top.
- All tops cannot have any profanity, sex, drugs, gang messaging not advertise alcohol or tobacco products.
- No Tube Tops or Tank Tops.
- No "see-through" material (example: mesh)

Bottoms

- Shorts, skirts or dresses worn at Jeff/Silva must be longer than the student's tips of the fingers of the student when standing straight.
- All pants/jeans must be worn at the waist: no revealing underwear
- Pants should not be extremely baggy
- No pajama pants unless allowed by special event.
- Ripped jeans are allowed but undergarments and private parts cannot be exposed. When wearing ripped jeans, inside pocket should not be visible. Rips and tears should not be more than six inches in width. Rips in the thigh area and the back of the upper leg, should not be above the fingertips, would require students to wear some sort of leggings underneath.
- Leggings are allowed only with a long shirt is worn to cover the hip/thigh area.

Shoes

- Shoes must be worn at all times on school campus.
- Slippers with soft soles are not allowed as shoes (unless allowed by special event) because they present a safety hazard.
- Slippers with hard soles (flip-flops, slides, sandals) are acceptable.

Head Coverings

- No hats, hoods or anything that fully covers your head may be worn inside the building. (Head coverings based on religious beliefs will be allowed.)

Miscellaneous

- Any clothing or jewelry displaying words or pictures that are lewd, vulgar, obscene, profane or offensive may not be worn.
- Any clothing, jewelry, or tattoos that advertise or promote illegal drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, violence, gang affiliation, or racist ideas may not be worn.
- Bandanas are not allowed as a hat, belt, or hanging from pocket.
- Clothing, piercings, and/or general appearance which might constitute a health or safety hazard are prohibited.
