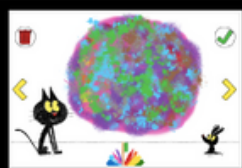

Think of all the ways you can create a Dot Day mural by yourself or with friends. You can even **make sidewalk chalk** and go outside to make one too!

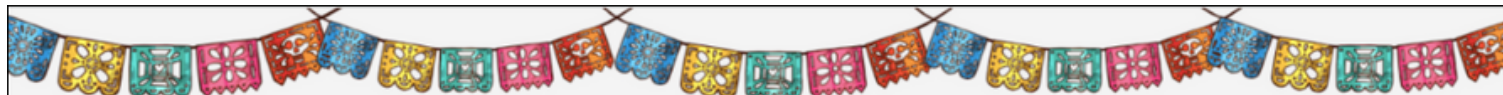

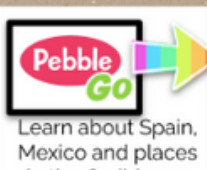
