Annual Asbestos Notification

The El Paso Independent School District, as partial fulfillment of the EPA's Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), conducts periodic surveillance every six months of the asbestos containing building materials remaining in its facilities. These inspections are to ensure that the asbestos materials are maintained in good condition. Every three years the district conducts a complete re-inspection of all of its buildings with the assessment results and updated drawings entered into the AHERA Management Plan. The next re-inspection is scheduled for 2018 and will be conducted by an AHERA Accredited Inspector as mandated by state and federal regulation. A copy of the Asbestos Inspection report and Management Plan are available for review at the office of each campus and at the Department of Facilities and Construction located at the Education Center, 6531 Boeing Dr., 79925.

The EPISD has removed asbestos containing building materials from its buildings in support of maintenance activities and construction related projects; a schedule of past and planned abatement projects can be provided upon request. The EPISD strives to ensure that a safe work and learning environment is maintained through staff training and responsive operations and maintenance activities.
