## FLOW CHART OF BEHAVIOR LEVEL 1 EX: DISRUPTION, DISRESPECT, PREPARDNESS

Level 1 infractions are those discipline issues that the classroom teacher will handle without the assistance of the administrators. By using classroom rules, consequences, and positive recognition, Level 1 infractions will normally not escalate to a higher level. Teachers must contact parents.

## LEVEL 2 EX: OUTBURTS, EXCESSIVE TEASING, VULGAR LANGUAGE, EXTREME DEFIANCE

Level 2 referrals do not require the immediate attention of the administrative staff. At the time of the Level 2 discipline infraction, the teacher will maintain the child in the classroom to continue with the educational process. A discipline referral will be entered in TEAMS as to the nature of the infraction, at which time the administrator will make every effort to see the student in a timely manner. Teachers must contact parents.

## Level 3

EX: Illegal weapons, drugs, harassment, assault fighting, vandalism, theft

Level 3 referrals require the immediate attention of the administrative staff. When making a Level 3 referral, the student involved will be sent or escorted to the office by the referring staff member or taken to the office by an administrator. A completed discipline referral will be entered into TEAMS and the student will be sent to the office immediately after the incident/infraction.
