Review of NHS responsibilities 2021-2022

Membership in the National Honor Society is both an honor and a responsibility. Students selected for membership are expected to continually demonstrate the qualities of scholarship, service, leadership, and character by which they were selected.

National Honor Society at Jefferson/Silva Magnet requires that students do the following:

- ❖ Maintain the standards by which they were selected (i.e. continued performance at or above the 90.0 GPA, service, leadership and character).
- ❖ Attend all NHS meetings. There are only two absences allowed with a written excuse given to the sponsor.
- Complete a minimum of 25 community service hours and 15 school service hours per semester.
- ❖ All members are required to participate in **one annual school AND one community group project** organized by the officers
- ❖ Pay yearly dues \$10 on time.
- ❖ Attend homecoming decorating events if NHS is participating
- ❖ Attend the NHS induction ceremony

If these requirements are not met, the member runs the risk of being placed on probation or of being dismissed. Any senior placed on probation the second semester will not wear the NHS collar for graduation and will not get a refund. Member can only be placed on probation once.

SERVICE HOURS: check with your NHS sponsor if you have any doubts concerning the validity of any service hours.

SCHOOL SERVICE HOURS:

- O Volunteer hours given to serve Jefferson/Silva high school.
- o These hours need to be served before school or after school (**not during school time**)
- Time either required or implicit for course credit or courtesy is not considered NHS volunteer time.
 - To complete school service hours, the school clubs or organizations can:
 - ✓ Organize a school health fair
 - ✓ Run a school clean-up campaign
 - ✓ Usher school events
 - ✓ Plan freshman/new student orientation
 - ✓ Set up a consistent peer tutoring program (not on a one to one basis, but must involve a group of 5 or more students and supervised by a teacher)
- o The school service hours can be obtained by joining the following school clubs or organizations:

- *any activity performed during class time or for which you receive school credit/courtesy will not count.

COMMUNITY HOURS: (volunteer hours which benefit the local COMMUNITY AT LARGE).

- o These hours must be completed before/after school, weekends, or holidays.
- The following will not count as community hours:
 - services toward one individual
 - ✓ Tutoring a relative/neighbor or one student
 - ✓ Baby-sitting without charge
 - ✓ Cleaning a neighbor's yard/house, or running errands for them
 - ✓ Helping an individual teacher file, grade papers etc.
 - ✓ Helping an individual at their work place: banks, offices, construction companies, car wash, swap meets, doctor's office, law office, etc.
- O Your community hours must come FROM A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION)
 - ➤ Church activities/groups
 - > Hospitals
 - Nursing homes
 - > Shelters
 - > Hospice
 - > Group organized neighborhood clean up
 - > Scout troops, etc.
- **Forms for service verification are available from the NHS sponsor, any officer or the webpage.**
- **The sponsor has the final approval of acceptability of school or community service hours.**
- **A** letter-head or business card must be attached to the community hour form.
- **❖** If there is any doubt as to the acceptability of the service hours, it should be handled in advanced of service rendered.
