All EPISD Middle School's will waive the school uniform policy for the 2020-21 school year. Students are encouraged to show their Brown Middle School pride and wear a Brown Middle School polo or t-shirt.

Attire must comply with the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Are not lewd, offensive, vulgar, or obscene• Do not advertise or depict tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs or any other substance prohibited under FNCF (LOCAL)• Do not show evidence of membership of affiliation in any gang, unauthorized club or organization under FNCC (LOCAL) <p>All students are required to wear a facemask. Facemask must also adhere to the above guidelines.</p>	<p>Unacceptable items:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Oversized, baggy, sagging, low rise, pants, thin leggings or jeggings.• Pants with holes or huge tears not allowed. Small tears on jeans allowed.• Extreme make-up• Excessive jewelry• Hoop earrings longer than 1" in diameter• Gauges or ear spikes• Chains• Inappropriate writing on clothing• Studded items• Facial piercings• Sandals, slippers, open-toed or backless shoes, crocs, or flip-flops• Pajama wear• Tank tops/Spaghetti straps• Low cut shirts• See-through shirts• Crop tops (shows midriff)
